Funding and Corporate Sponsors

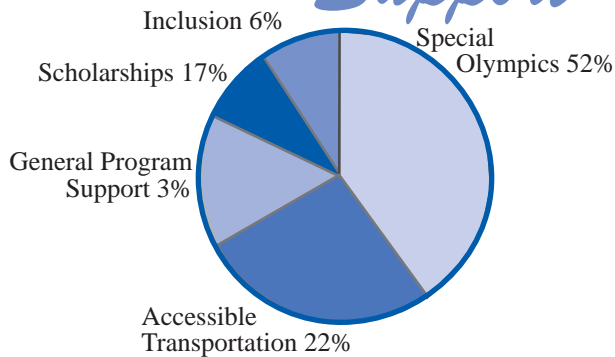
