The Arlington Heights Park District is in the process of remodeling the Olympic Indoor Swim center and is planning on making the following improvements to make the building more accessible and to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act:

Add a passenger elevator	\$104,000
Add ADA washrooms in lower level	\$100,000
Add ADA washrooms in upper level (part of family changing area	\$ 60,000
Add deep water stairs in diving well	\$ 50,000
Create a zero depth entry in leisure pool	\$ 30,000
Replace existing door hardware and make ADA	\$ 6,000
Purchase accessible lift for lap pool	\$ 3,200
TOTAL	\$353,200

The Arlington Heights Park District is planning to utilize the funds available for ADA building and playground dollars that were included in the Park District 2003 Tax Levy as part of the Special Recreation Association levy. The Arlington Heights Park District is requesting approval from the NWSRA Board of Directors for this project.

Dear Ms. Julison:

The Bartlett Park District hereby notifies and requests approval of the NWSRA Board of Directors for the proposed expenditure of funds from the District's special recreation levy to pay the cost of the following improvement.

WALNUT CORNER PARK ACCESSIBLE PLAYGROUND

The estimated cost of the portions of the ADA related improvements to this park and playground is \$10,000. The improvements are expected to be substantially complete by December 15, 2004. Anticipated benefits of the project to NWSRA are as follows:

Walnut Corner Park is a small neighborhood park with one-half basketball court and a non-ADA accessible playground built in 1990. The existing playground is in the process of being replaced with an accessible composite play structure with an engineered wood fiber safety surface. The play area will have an accessible route via a new concrete sidewalk with curb ramps to the play surface and to the crosswalk.

Renovations

Dear Susie:

The Hanover Park Park District has contracted with J. A. Johnson Paving, Inc. of Arlington Heights, Illinois to renovate three of our largest parking lots within the Park District. Work is scheduled to begin on May 17, 2004.

As per the understanding of the appropriate uses of the new authority granted through SB 1881 and the NWSRA Board of Trustees, the Park District wishes to set aside and to utilize a portion of that authority toward the amount required for handicapped parking, including design, engineering, construction and construction management (including a contingency amount) for all three parking lots.

The contract amount (including a 10% contingency) is \$450,372. The portion pertaining to handicapped parking represents \$38,921 of that. Design, engineering, testing and construction management totals \$64,176, with \$5,546 designated toward handicapped parking. The total amount being requested for handicapped parking will not exceed \$44,467.

As we have discussed in the past, the staff of NWSRA/SLSF is in dire need of a storage facility that will not only consolidate the current storage areas, but allow for an area for staging events. After several visits to the River Trails Park District 550 Business Center Drive facility, we believe that this is will fit their needs.

The River Trails Park District is currently in the process of planning phase I of renovations to this facility and would like to include the NWSRA/SLSF storage area. Because of the uncertain future changes in the park district's plans, we are not willing to sell off a portion of the building, such as Rolling Meadows Park District with NWSRA/SLSF office space. Instead it would be a month-to-month lease for 2340 square feet at \$7/square foot (totally a yearly cost of \$16,380). The River Trails Park District would incur the construction costs and this does include utilities.

This memo also is to ask the board for permission to use Special Recreation funds for this development. Current costs estimates are as follows:

TOTAL (Not to exceed)	\$90,000
5 – ADA Toilet Facilities (Not in storage area at this time)	\$35,000
4 – Miscellaneous Expenses	\$ 5,000
3 - Fire wall for dividing storage area from assembly area	\$28,000
2 - Shelves and cabinets per NWSRA/SLSF staff	\$ 7,000
1-12' Cyclone fence enclosure (materials and installation)	\$20,000

If the permit process goes well with the Village, we hope to begin as soon as possible with the storage facility, as staff is "chopping at the bit" as my grandmother would have said. The bathroom renovation will not begin until September/October.
