Raven Park Tennis & Basketball Courts Replacement

The project consisted of the removal and replacement of the existing tennis and basketball courts and the installation of an accessible concrete walk to the courts. These improvements were completed in the spring of 2015. The benefits to NWSRA are to provide accessible park amenities as well as an accessible route to park amenities. The site was not previously accessible.



Arlington Lakes Golf Course Cart Paths

The project consisted of the installation of new accessible 8' wide asphalt paths throughout the golf course. These improvements were completed in the summer of 2015. The benefits of this project to NWSRA are to provide an accessible path around the course and an accessible route to the course amenities. The site was not previously accessible.



Festival Park Playground Improvements

The project consisted of the removal and replacement of the existing playground with new accessible equipment and surfacing. These improvements were completed in the summer of 2015. The benefits to NWSRA are to provide accessible play activities that enable children to interact, play, and learn social skills. The site was not previously accessible.



Festival Park Gazebo Replacement

The project consisted of the demolition and replacement of one gazebo in Festival Park. The gazebo was not previously accessible. Included in the project was the installation of a new accessible concrete pad and the purchase and installation of a new gazebo. These improvements were completed summer of 2015 in conjunction with the playground project. The benefits of this project to NWSRA are to provide an accessible pad under the gazebo and install a new accessible gazebo model.



Hasbrook Park – ADA Access to Baseball Fields #1 & #2

For Baseball Field #1 the project consisted of the installation of a new 5' wide concrete walk from the existing park path to the baseball field. For Baseball Field #2 the project consisted of the installation of a new 9' wide concrete walk and concrete pads for player's benches and bleachers. These improvements were completed summer of 2015. The benefits of this project to NWSRA are to provide an accessible walk to the baseball field, player's benches, and bleachers because the site was not previously accessible.



Porta Potty Enclosures – Melas Park & Patriots Park

The project consisted of the installation of new concrete pads for accessible portable toilet units in Melas and Patriots Park. The size of the concrete pad allows the park district to use the larger ADA compliant portable toilet model. These improvements were completed in the summer of 2015. The benefits of this project to NWSRA are to provide an accessible path to the portable toilet units and a permanent location for the accessible portable toilet units.

Patriots Park Concrete Walk Improvements

The project consisted of the installation of a new accessible 7' wide concrete walk from the school path to the parking lot and from the parking lot to the baseball field. These improvements were completed in the summer of 2015. The benefits of this project to NWSRA are to provide an accessible walk around the park and an accessible route to the park amenities. The former asphalt path was not previously accessible.



Rose Garden Concrete Walk Improvements

This project consisted of the installation of new accessible 5' wide concrete walks from the Rose Garden to Frontage Road and two accessible concrete pads for new benches. These improvements were completed in the summer of 2015. The benefits of this project to NWSRA are to provide accessible walks around the park and accessible concrete pads for the park amenities. The former asphalt path and site amenities were not previously accessible.



Raven Park Concrete Walk Improvements

This project consisted of the installation of new 5'-9' wide, accessible concrete walks around Raven Park, concrete pads for player's benches and bleachers around the southwest baseball field, a concrete pad for an accessible portable toilet unit, and concrete pads for new site amenities. These improvements were completed in the summer of 2015. The benefits of this project to NWSRA are to provide an accessible walk around the park, an accessible walk to the park amenities, and accessible site amenities. The former asphalt path was not previously accessible.



Recreation Park ADA Drinking Fountain

This project consisted of the installation of a new concrete walk and a new universal design drinking fountain. The former concrete pavement was heaving, cracking, and holding water and needed to be replaced to make the fountain accessible again. These improvements were completed in the summer of 2015. The benefits of this project to NWSRA are to provide an accessible route to the drinking fountain and an accessible drinking fountain model.



Recreation Park Drop Off Area Improvements


This project consisted of the installation of an asphalt overlay for an existing driveway/drop off area. The existing asphalt was cracking and crumbling and was not previously accessible. These improvements were completed in the fall of 2015. The benefits of this project to NWSRA are to provide an accessible pavement surface within the drop off area for park patrons.




Park Furniture Replacements – Misc. Parks

This project consisted of the installation of new site amenities and replacement of existing site amenities that were not previously accessible. Site amenities included picnic tables and benches. The concrete pads for the site amenities were installed as part of the Concrete Improvements Project. These improvements were completed in the fall of 2015. The benefits of this project to NWSRA are to provide accessible site amenities in the parks.

Festival Park Playground Equipment Accessible Features





The project consisted of the removal of the old playground equipment and wood fiber safety surfacing, installation of a new playground with accessible play equipment and safety surfacing. A new concrete pad and entry walk were also installed for the new gazebo. These improvements were completed in the summer of 2015. The benefits to NWSRA are as follows: (1) provides accessible play activities and site amenities, (2) enables children to interact and play, (3) enables children to learn social skills, and (4) provides an accessible gazebo for shade and relief from the elements. Previously, the site was accessible up to the old playground border, however the old play equipment was not up to the current accessibility standards. We are requesting 62% of the total cost for these upgrades. This includes a percentage of the equipment cost, demolition, excavation, installation, and restoration of the playground, and the cost for the safety surfacing.





STEP 2:

- USE 2 - PCS. END CONTOUR STRAP (6)
 4 - PCS. 1/2" X 2 1/2" FLT SKT. HD. CAP SCR. (8)
- ATTACH END CONTOUR STRAPS (6) TO STEP 1 ASSEMBLY USING HARDWARE (8). TIGHTEN TO SNUG FIT.



 4 - PCS. 5/16" X 1" SS. BTN SKT HD CAP SCR (9)

- ATTACH 71" SEAT BRACE (3) TO STEP 2 ASSEMBLY USING HARDWARE (9, 11 & 12). TIGHTEN TO SNUG FIT.

- USE 2 - PCS. CENTER CONTOUR STRAP (5)
 4 - PCS. 5/16" X 1" SS. BTN SKT HD CAP SCR (9)
 4 - PCS. 5/16" SS. NYLON LOCKNUT (11)
 8 - PCS. 5/16" SS. FLAT WASHER (12)
- ATTACH CENTER CONTOUR STRAP (5) TO STEP 3 ASSEMBLY USING HARDWARE (9, 11 & 12). TIGHTEN TO SNUG FIT.

STEP 5:

- USE 9 - PCS. 2" X 3" X 71" PLASTIC INT'R SLAT (1)
 2 - PCS. 2" X 3" X 71" PLASTIC EDGE SLAT (2)
 44 - PCS. 5/16" X 1 1/2" SS. BTN. SKT. HD. LAG (10)
 44 - PCS. 5/16" SS. FLAT WASHER (12)
- ATTACH 2" X 3" X 71" PLASTIC SLATS (1 & 2) TO STEP 4 ASSEMBLY USING HARDWARE (10 & 12). TIGHTEN TO SNUG FIT.
 REPEAT UNTIL ALL SLATS ARE ATTACHED.
