Re: Accessibility Fund Reimbursement, Golf Course GPS System Lease

Dear Tracey,

The Mt. Prospect Park District (Mt. Prospect Golf Club) will be renewing our annual lease for Club Car Visage GPS Systems on each golf cart at our golf course. We request the following funds be reimbursed to the Mt. Prospect Park District for Accessibility improvements. The funds will be used for a portion of the lease agreement. This request was put forth for last year's GPS lease and approved.

The Visage GPS System at the MPGC assists people with a mobility impairment and has emergency communication capability. The GPS can be set to allow people with mobility impairment to be able to allow the golf carts off the cart paths near tees and greens, which shortens the distance they need to walk to access these areas. Also, during wet conditions, golf carts are set to be restricted to cart paths only around the entire course but the GPS again allows people with mobility impairment to drive off the cart paths to their golf ball. We know that regularly about 20% of the users of golf carts have identified themselves for the need of the special GPS access.

The total cost of the Visage GPS System lease is \$35,657.82, we request reimbursement for 20% of the lease amount of \$7,131.56. If you have any questions, please contact me at 847.259.4200 Ext 307 or jlangguth@mppd.org.
