

NWSRA SMS Terms & Conditions

NWSRA utilizes text message communication for a number of reasons outlined in the following terms and conditions. Information obtained as part of the SMS consent process will not be shared with third parties for marketing purposes. If you have consented to receive text messages from Northwest Special Recreation Association, you may receive messages related to the following: emergency program updates, upcoming program opportunities from NWSRA, communication from NWSRA staff to program participants or their families and other general communications from NWSRA staff.

NWSRA's SMS message frequency is estimated to be less than 10 text messages per individual, per month; however, that number can vary depending on potential back and forth communication to families.

Please note that standard message and data rates may apply, depending on your carrier's pricing plan. These fees may vary if the message is sent domestically or internationally.

You may opt-in to receive SMS messages from Northwest Special Recreation Association in the following ways

- Via NWSRA's program registration process

You can opt out of receiving SMS messages at any time. To do so, simply reply "STOP" to any SMS message you receive. Alternatively, you can contact us directly to request removal from our messaging list.
